# **TOURNAMENT SYSTEM AND TIE-BREAK REGULATIONS**

The tournament will be played according to FIDE Laws of Chess in the Swiss system for 11 rounds with the time control 3 minutes + 2 extra seconds for each move. A player can be late for the round up to 3 minutes.

In case of equal points between two or more chess players, the tie-break will be as follows:

- a) results of direct encounters between the tied players
- b) reduced Buchholz-1 (sum of opponents' points excluding the weakest result)
- c) reduced Buchholz-2 (sum of opponents' points excluding the 2 weakest results)
- d) Buchholz (sum of opponents' points)
- e) highest number of games played with black

The tournament will go into the calculation of both Estonian and FIDE blitz rating. All disputes will be resolved by the chief arbiter of the tournament.

- c) reduced Buchholz-2 (sum of opponents' points excluding the 2 weakest results)
- d) Buchholz (sum of opponents' points)
- e) highest number of games played with black

The tournament will go into the calculation of both Estonian and FIDE rapid rating. All disputes will be resolved by the chief arbiter of the tournament.

# **REGULATIONS**

#### 1. PURPOSE

- 1) Chess popularisation
- 2) To give chess players a chance to compete
- 3) To determine the winners of Mövenpick Open

#### 2. TIME AND PLACE

The tournament will take place on **12 May 2024** in the Mövenpick hotel (Lembitu 12, Tallinn) conference hall starting at **11.00**. Registration and presence check of pre-registered players will be completed by 10.40 the latest.

#### 3. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM AND TIE-BREAK REGULATIONS

The tournament will be played in the Swiss system for 9 rounds. The time control is 10 minutes + 3 seconds increment per move starting move 1. The schedule is dynamic; you may be late for the round by up to 5 minutes.

In case of equal points between two or more chess players, the tie-break will be as follows:

- a) results of direct encounters between the tied players
- b) reduced Buchholz-1 (sum of opponents' points excluding the weakest result)
- c) reduced Buchholz-2 (sum of opponents' points excluding the 2 weakest results)
- d) Buchholz (sum of opponents' points)
- e) highest number of games played with black

The tournament will be played according to FIDE Laws of Chess. All disputes will be resolved by the chief arbiter.
